STUDENT TRIP CONTRIBUTION AND CREDIT POLICY 2016-17

Purpose: By participating in fund raising, students earn "credits" to replace a portion of the cost of the annual Band trip. Each credit earned will reduce the student's cost of the trip by \$5. <u>High School Band and Guard members are expected to earn a quota of 100 credits (to reduce trip cost by \$500)</u>. Middle School Band members are expected to earn a quota of 25 credits (to reduce trip cost by \$125). Note that the total cost of the Middle School trip is considerably lower than that of the High School trip.

This trip credit year for 2016-17 runs from February 1st through December 31st.

TRIP CONTRIBUTION CREDIT POLICIES:

- 1. A student will earn 1 credit for every box of fudge sold.
- 2. A student will earn 1 credit for every \$20.00 of pizza/snacks sold.
- 3. A student will earn 1 credit for every \$100 Giant or Karns gift cards purchased/sold. Cards purchased after Jan. 1st will be applied to the following year's Band trip. Indoor Guard participants may additionally apply Gift Card Credits earned from Jan. 1st to March 31st toward the trip to TIA championship at Wildwood (and will follow a separate fundraising policy).
- 4. A student will earn 1 credit for each hour of approved service. Hours may be worked by the band member or parent/guardian only. Service activities include working the fudge weekend and special projects as defined by the Band Director.
- 5. Fudge work hours may not exceed 6 credit hours for High School Band members. 7/8 Grade Band members do not participate in the fudge making but may qualify for set-up and clean-up service hours if additional help is needed.
- 6. Credits will be earned for one school year at a time. Extra credits earned over the quota for a school year cannot be transferred or banked for the following year.
- 7. Credits may not be transferred between students EXCEPT when students are in the same family.
- 8. Families with more than one student in **High School Band** may earn additional credits over and above the defined quotas in order to further reduce the trip cost. Please see the Band Director as early as possible in the school year to discuss details.
- 9. Students failing to meet their trip contribution credit quota may still attend the band trip by contributing \$5.00 in place of each credit not earned.
